DAY 01/02: 27 JUNE – REYKJAVIK

26th of June: Departure from USA / CANADA

27th of June: Arriving in Reykjavik

Transfer to your hotel.

Enjoy the journey through exotic ancient lava fields as you head back to your hotel in Reykjavík. These lava fields are part of the Reykjanes Peninsula, now designated as a UNESCO Geo Park for its unique volcanic features. The ride takes about 45 minutes and passes through the lunar landscape and moss-covered lava fields of the Reykjanes Peninsula.

DAY 03: 28 JUNE 2026 - THINGVELLIR / GEYSIR & GULLFOSS / HVOLSVOLLUR

Breakfast at your hotel.

Departure from Reykjavík for the south of Iceland. Head to Thingvellir National Park to explore the grounds of the former Alingi Parliament, on the shores of Iceland's largest lake. Thingvellir also showcases the dramatic drift between the American and Eurasian tectonic plates. Continue to Iceland's famous Gullfoss or 'Golden Falls', and the nearby Geysir Hot Springs area to discover numerous boiling mud pools.

Visit the greenhouse at Fríðheimar Organic Farm, where you can see

how vegetables are grown using Icelandic geothermal energy.

Enjoy an introduction to the unique Icelandic horse breed, which has a special fifth gait – the "tölt".

DAY 04: 29 JUNE - SELJALANDSFOSS / SKOGARFOSS / VIK / KIRKJUBAEJARKLAUSTUR

Breakfast at your hotel.

We start the day with the beautiful waterfalls, Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls, before arriving at Dyrhólaey nature reserve.

Continue to the charming village of Vík where you can stroll on the beautiful black sand beach.



Cross Eldhraun, an impressive lava flow. It is the largest lava flow to have occurred on Earth in recorded history.

Make a stop near Kirkjubæjarklaustur and its green surroundings which contrast with the surrounding lava fields and black sand deserts.

The tour continues over the volcanic sands of Skeiðarársandur to Skaftafell, a magnificent glacial region that is part of the vast Vatnajökull national park system.

Enjoy magnificent views of the mighty Vatnajökull, the largest glacier in Europe.

DAY 05: 30 JUNE 2026 - JOKULSARLON / DJUPIVOGUR / EGILSSTADIR

Breakfast at your hotel.

This morning we are heading to the superb Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon to observe the floating icebergs. You might also spot seals sunbathing on the ice. Enjoy a boat ride on the lagoon and sail among the majestic icebergs.







From Höfn, cross the Almannaskarð, pass and stop to admire the majestic coastline.







Lunch under your own arrangement. Continue on to the fjords with the magnificent view to the east. Here you can see the history in stone of the East Fjords, one of the geologically oldest regions of Iceland. (Roads and landscapes may be different than in the photos depending on the current weather).

DAY 06: 01 JUILLET 2026 - MODRUDALUR / MYVATN / GODAFOSS / AKUREYRI

Breakfast at your hotel.

Explore the empty vastness desert plateau of the Möðrudalsöræfi highlands, towards the Lake Mývatn region. Visit the Námaskarð pass with its boiling mud pools and vibrant colors. Explore the natural beauty of the Lake Mývatn region, including the distinctive lava formations of Dimmuborgir, the pseudocraters of Skútustaðir.

Lunch under your own arrangement.

One of the claims of the Mývatn region is that it is home to more species of ducks than any other place on Earth, as well as many other bird species. Head to the port and town of Akureyri, a bustling northern town, and stop at the magnificent Goðafoss Waterfall.



Diner under your own arrangement and night in the region of Akureyri (check-in for 2 nights). (AKUREYRI HOTEL)





DAY 07: 02 JULY 2026 – HAUGANES / SIGLUFJORDUR / AKUREYRI

Breakfast at your hotel.

Today's journey takes you along a beautiful coastal road lined with rugged mountains and fjords, as you head north towards the Arctic Circle. Along the way, stop in the fishing village of Hauganes, renowned for its high quality fish (bacalao).

Visit the town's family-owned Ektafiskur factory for a lively tour and learn how freshly caught Icelandic fish is transformed into delicious bacalao sold to gourmet shops and restaurants around the world. You will have the opportunity to taste their salted fish

In the afternoon, at the top of the fjord, visit the town of Siglufjörður.

Siglufjörður is Iceland's northernmost town and is a historic fishing town whose fame, and fortune has always been linked to the ebb and flow of the fishing industry. A tiny shark fishing village in 1900, Siglufjörður soon became one of the largest towns in Iceland and the undisputed capital of herring fishing in the Atlantic. Siglufjörður is an area of spectacular natural beauty.



Visit the Herring museum.

Back to Akureyri at the end of the day.

DAY 08: 03 JULY 2026 - GLAUMBAER / KOLUGLJUFUR CANYON / HUSAFELL

Breakfast at your hotel.

This morning we will visit the historic Glaumbær Turf House at the Glaumbær Museum. (Outdoor Peat Museum)








A farm has stood on this site since Iceland was settled in 874 - give or take a few years, and people lived in Glaumbær's turf house until 1947.

The current farm consists of 13 buildings and the "newer" addition to the turf house was built in 1876-1879. The oldest parts of the turf house date from the mid-18th century.

We will continue towards Kolugljufur Canyon and Grabrok crater for a walk. We will also top at Hraunfossar and Barnafoss Waterfalls before heading to Husafell.

DAY 09: 04 JULY 2026 - LANGJOKULL / KRAUMA SPA / DEPART

Breakfast at your hotel.

Today you have two choices. You can book the optional activity "Into the Glacier" or go hiking for several kilometers starting from the hotel's trails (Lunch not included).

** OPTIONAL ACTIVITY (180 EUR) ** must be booked in advance

Explore Iceland's second largest glacier from the inside! This trip takes you on a guided tour in a monster truck to the entrance of Langjokull Ice Cave.





The artificial Langjökull Glacier Tunnel is the largest of its kind in the world. We will explore the tunnels for an hour, stopping at the integrated chapel. Venture into the heart of the Icelandic Ice Age, truly a unique opportunity and an experience not to be missed.

OR

Go hiking from the hotel trails in Husafell.

(For all levels). No extra charge.













In the afternoon, relax at the geothermal baths natural at Krauma's spa.

The hot water comes from Europe's most powerful hot spring Deildartunguhver, at a temperature of 100°C

(212°F). Krauma offers several different pools, each with their own unique features and characteristics, all heated naturally by the earth's core. Pool temperatures range from 37 to 41 degrees Celsius and the cold pool for cooling off, with temperatures ranging from 5 to 10 degrees Celsius.

No additional chemicals are needed to keep the pools clean, as the water is constantly replaced due to the rapid natural flow of the hot springs. The cloakroom has a separate locker for each guest. Krauma also has two saunas, an infrared cell and a steam bath;

both offering a wide range of wellness benefits.

FORMALITIES:

- Your passport must be valid for at least three months beyond your intended date of departure from Iceland, six months is recommended beyond your planned date of departure from the Schengen area.
- Iceland is a party to the Schengen Agreement. This means that U.S. citizens may enter Iceland without a visa for up to 90 days for tourist or business purposes.
- Canadian citizens do not need a visa for travel to countries within the Schengen area. However, visa-free travel only applies to stays of up to 90 days in any 180-day period.
