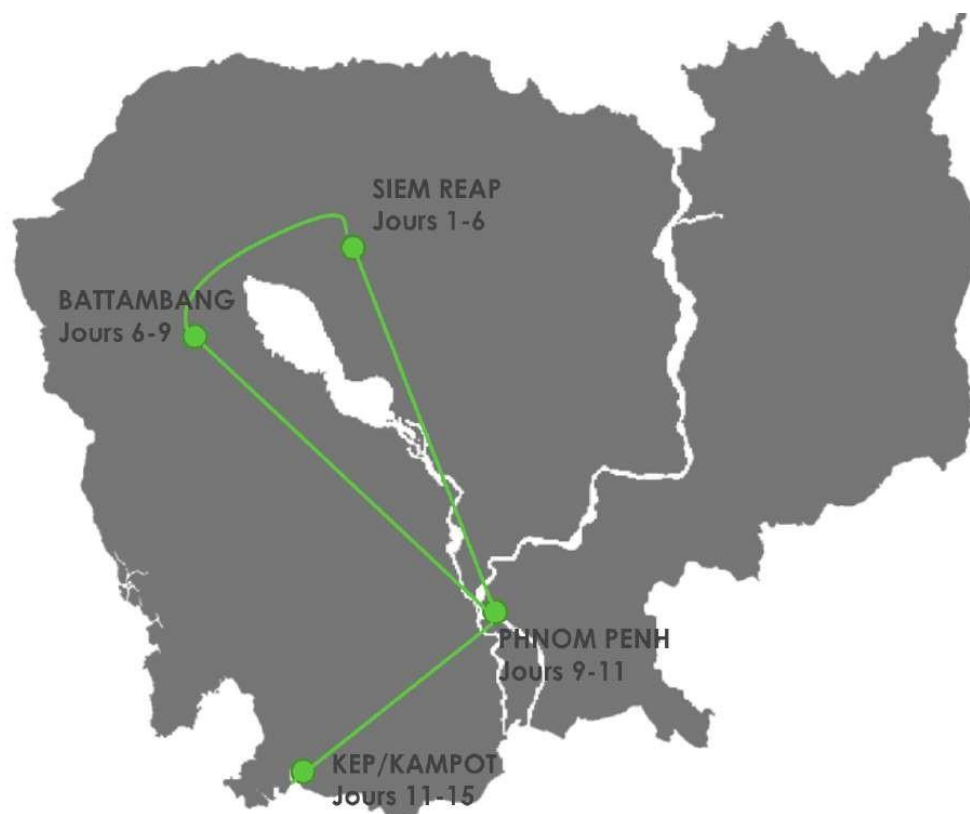


CAMBODIA

DAY 1 - 21/01 : ARRIVAL IN SIEM REAP

(depart from your departing airport on the 20th of January 2027)

- **Arrival in Siem Reap**
- Welcome by Anne-Marie and transfer to your hotel.
Check-in (5 nights)
- **Lunch or Dinner included** and night in Siem Reap.



DAY 2 - 22/01 : : BANTEAY SREI, GOLDEN SILK, BANTEAY SAMRÉ & APOPO

- After your breakfast, departure for **Banteay Srei**, the Citadel of Women located about twenty kilometres northeast of Angkor.
- Afterwards you will visit a **silk preservation center**. Discover a unique and rare art that respects ancestral traditions.
- **Lunch included in a local restaurant.**
- After lunch, visit the **temple of Banteay Samre** and return to Siem Reap for a visit at the demining center of the NGO Apopo which carries out a titanic work in Cambodia. Thanks to its "HeroRats".
- Dinner under your own arrangements and night in Siem Reap.



DAY 3 - 23/01 : THE CITY OF ANGKOR WAT / PROHM TEMPLE / ANGHOR THOM

- Departure in private tuk-tuks for a visit to the famous **Ta Prohm temple**, from the famous Tomb Raider movie. Then continue to **Angkor Thom** with the majestic Bayon, as well as the Terrace of the Elephants and the Leper King.
- **Lunch included** near Srah Srang in a private traditional house.
- In the afternoon let's visit the temple of **Angkor Wat**, the largest religious monument in the world, before continuing towards the south gate of **Angkor Thom** from where you will observe the sunset.
- Back at your hotel after the tours and free time.
- Dinner under your own arrangements and night in Siem Reap.



DAY 4 - 24/01 : KBAL SPEAN, PREAH KHAN AND NEAK POAN

- After breakfast, depart in a private vehicle for **Kbal Spean**, also known as the River of a "thousand Lingas". After a walk in the forest (1 hour), enjoy a break by the waterfall.
- **Lunch included** in a restaurant nearby.
- After lunch set off to visit the **Preah Khan temple**, the former Royal Palace and the little-known **Neak Poan**, surrounded by water.
- Return to the hotel for some rest before your early evening departure to the **Phare circus for a dinner show.**



DAY 5 - 25/01 : COOKING IMMERSION CLASE AND HANDCRAFT OF EXCEPTION

- After breakfast depart for a **private cooking class in the countryside** with a chef trained at one of the region's top culinary schools. He uses his days off to welcome you to his home and family's village, nestled amidst rice and lotus fields. Share his traditional cuisine secret in the heart of an authentic Cambodia countryside. **Lunch included** and prepared on site by you.
- In the afternoon let's enjoy a **workshop with a master lacquer artist** who build his notoriety through many years. He is passionate about reviving the art of vegetal lacquer in Cambodia. Afterwards, you will discover a unique "**papier-mâché**" **sculpture technique**. The activity is housed in a traditional Khmer home. Return to the hotel at the end of the day.
- Dinner under your own arrangements in Siem Reap.



DAY 6 - 26/01 : EXCURSION ON THE TONLÉ SAP LAKE & DEPARTURE FOR BATTAMBANG

- After breakfast, depart towards the **floating villages on Tonlé Sap Lake**. Visit a local market along the way, then make various stops on the water to discover this unique way of life: floating school, church, pagoda on stilts, livestock farm...
- **Lunch included** in a floating restaurant.
- Back on land, you will meet your driver for your transfer to Battambang province, a 3-hour drive away.
- Arrival at the hotel in the late afternoon and check-in.
- **Dinner included** and night in Battambang.



DAY 7 - 27/01 : LOCAL CRAFTS AND SUNSET

- By tuk-tuk you will discover the authentic **Cambodian countryside** and its **traditional crafts. Lunch included.**
- Visit **Phnom Sampov** to discover the “killing cave”, a pagoda, and a reclining Buddha. End your journey at the top of the hill where you will witness thousands of bats taking flight at sunset. Return to the hotel.
- Dinner under your own arrangements in Battambang.



DAY 8 - 28/01 : BAMBOO TRAIN RIDE AND LOCAL CULTURAL VISITS

- After breakfast, let's head to the **central market, Psar Nhat**, located in the heart of the city. Then, you will visit the former residence of the French governor before heading to the bamboo train where you will embark on an approximately one-hour ride through the surrounding countryside.
- **Local lunch included.**
- In the afternoon you will continue the day with a visit to the **Angkorian temple** of Phnom Banan located on top of a hill, about twenty kilometers from the city center.
- Return to the hotel and free time. Dinner at leisure and overnight stay in Battambang.



DAY 9 - 29/01 : DE BATTAMBANG À PHNOM PENH / CITY OF OUDONG

- After breakfast, departure for Phnom Penh (approximately 5 hours' drive). Lunch break at your leisure along the way.
- On route stop for a visit to the **city of Oudong**, former capital of Cambodia in the 17th century.
- Arrived at your hotel in the late afternoon, dinner at your leisure and overnight stay in Phnom Penh.



DAY 10 - 30/01: FULL-DAY TO THE DISCOVERY OF PHNOM PENH

- A full day for an unusual discovery of the capital. You will explore the Phnom Penh of the Protectorate era by private vehicle, including a visit to Wat Phnom and the central market. Lunch is included in the city.
- L'après-midi : You will visit the infamous Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum with your guide. Return to the hotel after the visit and enjoy some free time.
- Departure in the early evening towards the banks of the river to board a 2-deck boat to enjoy a dinner cruise on the Mekong.
- Back to the hotel in Phnom Penh.



DAY 11 - 31/01: VISITES CULTURELLES & DÉPART VERS KAMPOT / KEP

- After breakfast, depart with your French-speaking guide in a private vehicle for a visit to the Royal Palace and its famous Silver Pagoda. Then, continue to the National Museum to discover its many treasures.
- Lunch is at your leisure after your visits.
- After your lunch, departure to the far south of Cambodia, towards the charming and peaceful town of Kampot (3.5 hours journey).
- Arrives at the end of the day, checks into the hotel and dinner is included on site.



DAY 12 - 01/02: EXCURSIONS IN THE ARCHIPELAGOS OF KEP / NATIONAL PARK

- Accompanied by a French-speaking guide, depart by private vehicle for Kep and embark on a traditional Khmer fishing boat for an exotic and relaxing half-day exploring the islands of the Kep archipelago and their authentic fishing villages, far from the tourist crowds. Swimming and snorkeling are available. (Morning or afternoon). Lunch is at your leisure upon your return.
- **Morning or afternoon free.** Self-guided walking tour of Kep National Park or self-guided tour of the nearby town of Kampot.
- Dinner under your own arrangements in Kampot.



DAY 13 - 02/02: KEP AND ITS SURROUNDINGS / SALT PANS / PEPPER PLANTATION

- Breakfast and departure for a discovery of the surroundings of Kep: visits Kep's salt pans and continuation towards Kampong Trach and its splendid karst hills.
- **Local lunch included.**
- Continue your day towards the Valley of the Lakes and its breathtaking panoramas and finish with a visit to a plantation of the famous **Kampot pepper**. Return to Kep at the end of the day.
- Back to the hotel in Kampot dinner under your own arrangements.



DAY 14 - 03/02: L'ÎLE AU LAPIN OU L'ÎLE AU SERPENT

- After breakfast, you'll depart for the pier to **visit Rabbit Island or Snake Island**, two islands in the region still untouched by mass tourism. You'll board a private fishing boat for a short crossing.
- **Lunch included.**
- **Free time in the afternoon** to enjoy the tranquility of the island and its beaches. Return around 4pm by private boat to the port, then to your hotel and free time.
- **Farewell dinner** in Kampot.



DAY 15 - 04/02 : LAST DAY

- Enjoy a final relaxing morning at the hotel before your departure to Phnom Penh International Airport, to catch your return flight (to be determined - ideally in the evening).
