DAY 01 – 22/10 – ARRIVAL DAY IN SARAJEVO, BOSNIA-HERZEGOVINA

You will be welcomed by Anne-Marie and transferred to your hotel.
Free time in the afternoon and dinner under your own arrangement.

DAY 02 – 23/10 - SARAJEVO

You will start the day with a guided walking tour of the historic city. **Sarajevo** is located on the Miljacka River and was founded in the mid-15th century during the Ottoman era. This rule lasted almost 4 centuries until the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Known as the “Jerusalem of Europe”, the city has many Jewish temples, mosques and churches. This incredible diversity was also the reason for such complicated recent history. Sarajevo is a city of extraordinary charm where you will have the impression of finding yourself in another world especially in the old Ottoman quarter where goldsmiths and craftsmen work on the doorstep of their workshops.

Lunch under your own arrangement and free time in the afternoon. **Dinner in a traditional restaurant.**

DAY 03 – 24/10 - MOSTAR / NEUM

After breakfast we will visit the “**tunnel of hope**”. The site is a museum featuring the Kolar family house, where one entrance was hidden and where a tunnel was constructed during the Siege of Sarajevo in the midst of the Bosnian War. We will head towards Mostar after the visit. (Approximately 2h30 driving time).

Mostar was developed in the 15th century as a frontier town of the Ottoman Empire. Almost completely destroyed during the fratricidal war of the 1990's, the Old Bridge district is now rebuilt. On a **guided walking tour**, you will discover the old district which is part of the UNESCO world heritage. Lunch under your own arrangement and we will continue towards the coast in the afternoon.



2 nights stay at the hotel in Neum. Dinner at hotel. **Hotel Sunce or Hotel Nova.**



DAY 04 – 25/10 - DUBROVNIK

This morning we will cross the border to reach **Dubrovnik** from Bosnia.

This magnificent medieval town was probably created in the first half of the 7th century. The town became the seat of a small republic. Its large merchant fleet ensured great wealth, which is visible today in the town's streets. Walk through this pearl of the Adriatic coast and discover its magnificent monuments on a guided walking tour.

Enjoy some free time for lunch and exploration.

Return to Neum (border crossing) for an unforgettable **musical and typical gastronomic dinner of the region.**



DAY 05 – 26/10 - KORCULA / STON / OYSTERS TASTING

Take the road to **Orebić on the Pelješac peninsula**. (Border crossing). Embark on the private boat for a short crossing to the **island of Korčula**.

Free time to discover the charm of this Mediterranean town, the birthplace of Marco Polo.

After some time, return to the continent and take the road towards **Ston** where we will embark on a boat to discover the **oyster culture** and enjoy a tasting.

Hotel in Drvenik. (1 night) Dinner at hotel.

DAY 06 – 27/10 - OMIS / SPLIT / BIOGRAD

This morning we are taking the beautiful coastal road to **Omiš**.

In Omis take an half-hour boat ride along the canyon. Free time for lunch then continuation to **Split**, the second Croatian city and capital of the Dalmatia region.

Guided tour of the historic center and discovery of 1700 years of history enshrined in the walls of the Roman Palace of Emperor.

Check-in at the hotel in Biograd for 2 nights. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 07 – 28/10 – TROGIR / ZADAR

This morning drive to **Trogir**.

Orientation tour of this medieval jewel inscribed on the UNESCO world heritage list.

Free time for lunch and personal discovery to enjoy the Mediterranean atmosphere of this cute town.

In the afternoon, we will continue towards **Zadar**.

Free time to discover the historic Roman center of the city.

Return to hotel and dinner.



DAY 08 – 29/10 – NATIONAL PARK OF PLITVICE / OPATIJA

Road to the mountainous region of Lika. Visit and walk in the **Plitvice National Park** (around 3 hours).
Lunch under your own arrangements.

Continue to the seaside resort of **Opatija**. Check-in at the hotel in Opatija for two nights.

Dinner at the hotel.

DAY 09 – 30/10 - MOTOVUN / TRUFFLES HUNT / ROVINJ

Road to central Istria known as the Croatian Tuscany towards **Motovun**, a small medieval town perched on the hill.

In the Motovun forest we will meet a local truffle hunting family. They will introduce you to their dogs and show you how a true **truffle hunt** takes place, in the heart of the Istrian countryside.

The experience will continue with a light truffle-based lunch, prepared with produce from their farm.

Continue to **Rovinj**, one of the most charming towns with colorful houses. Visit and free time, then return to Opatija.

Dinner under your own arrangement.



DAY 10 – 31/10 – POSTOJNA CAVES / BLED / LJUBLJANA

Let's go to Slovenia!

Road to **Postojna** (1h30) and visit its spectacular caves. Part of the visit is done by electric train, and another part on foot.

Next, head to Radovljica for a **demonstration of gingerbread making**, a long-standing tradition in Slovenia. The activity is followed by **lunch in a traditional restaurant**.

Continuation towards **Bled**, the famous health resort located on the edge of the homonymous lake, at the foot of the Alps. Panoramic visit of the lake and entry to the castle from which there is a magnificent view of the lake and the surrounding area. Road to the Slovenian capital **Ljubljana**.
Check-in at hotel for 2 nights.

Dinner under your own arrangement.

DAY 11 – 01/11 - LJUBLJANA

After breakfast, we are leaving for a **guided walking tour of the old town** with its iconic bridges such as the Dragon Bridge, the Central and St. Nicholas Cathedral.

The rest of the day is free to explore the charming center located around the Ljubljanica river, and its lively banks overlooked by the medieval castle.

Dinner under your own arrangement.



DAY 12 – 02/11 - ZAGREB

After breakfast we will be leaving for our final destination, Zagreb.

Start the visit with a **guided walking tour** of the city around the medieval upper town and the Austro-Hungarian lower town.

Free time for lunch and the afternoon.
Check-in at hotel for 1 night.

Farewell dinner in a restaurant.
